Do you know the laws in your municipality?

Many municipalities have ordinances regarding the keeping, harboring, maintaining and/or feeding of domestic cats.

Those laws may include licensing and vaccination requirements, restrictions on cats running at large, the abatement of nuisances, and/or the feeding of stray and/or feral cats.

Some municipalities also have limits on the number of animals that are permitted at one property and regulations regarding waste disposal.

Most of these ordinances serve to protect public health. Always best to learn local laws prior to adopting an animal and never begin feeding stray or feral cats or releasing altered cats outside without first checking local ordinances and contacting your local or county Health Department and/or Animal Control.
